


TURNIPS

CUT FLOMERS




Flowers' scents are as unique as the human fingerprint. So next time you're on a stroll, smell away!

BLUEBERRIES




Blueberries are grown on a bush.

MBRIS




Different herbs can be used for things like seasoning, salad leaves, insect repellent, tea flavors, and more! Goodies like that come in boxes of all sizes!

PUMPKINS





Pumpkins are a type of fruit because they carry seeds. Pumpkins are grown on all the continents except Antarctica. That much globetrotting, they deserve a nap.

PONSETTIA




Poinsettias come in 100 different varieties and colors.
